FORMAL ERASURE NOTICE**Overview

Where (a) a data subject has requested that personal data relating to him/ her be erased and the Trustee agrees with that request or (b) the Trustee has decided, further to an assessment of applicable data, that there are no legal grounds to justify the retention of particular data, the Trustee will decide to erase that data.

In accordance with recitals 65 and 66 and Articles 17 and 19 of the GDPR, the Trustee is required to notify third parties to whom relevant data has been disclosed (**relevant third parties**) of the erasure (or restriction of processing) of that data.

Notice

- erase all applicable data directly and notify the Trustee when you have done so.

Please note that where you decide that you are unable to erase applicable data, the Trustee reserves the right to forward justification of your decision to the Information Commissioner's Office.
